

## TANZANIA NSA ONLINE NETWORK

The Tanzania NSA Online Network is an online collaboration and learning platform that links together the most important stakeholders working on agricultural issues across Tanzanian's non-state actors.

## **CONCEPT / BACKGROUND**

Improving food seurity and effective agricultural policy in Tanzania requires a wide set of input from smallholder famers, and the public and private sector. These various non-state actors come together in person from time-to-time across disaggregated mechanisms and processes. Additionally, in events that do bring together non-state actors there remains a gap in post-event follow up, information sharing, and coordination. Furthermore, the dynamic agricultural sector in Tanzania requires real-time communication and collaboration across geographies, professions and organizational missions to identify best practices, challenges, and feedback in agriculture policy processes and developments in the agri-food system.




## A FREE TOOL FOR TANZANIA'S NSAs

In response to non-state actors requests for improved coordination amongst each other and improved efforts in tranformative agriculture policy, agribusiness and trade, Africa Lead has launched a limited-access online platform for a 90-day trial period to evaluate the ability of such an online tool to enhance collaboration, communication and learning across the public and private sector.

The collaboration platform -free to users- is based on the MangoApps collaboration technology and provides a robust mobile application and web-accessible platform which includes tools for issue tracking, document/file sharing, shared event calendars, Facebook-like social networking, video and photo sharing, news posting, and WhatsApp-like web and mobile chat.
